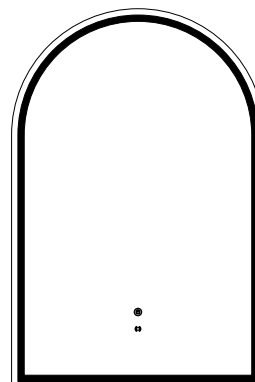
Customers can contact us for a refund or replacement if the product is defective.

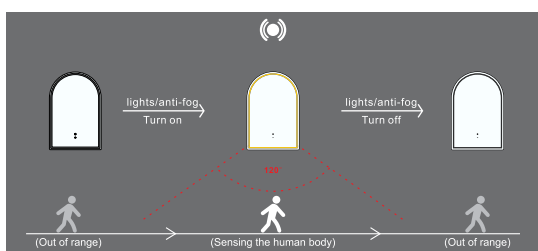

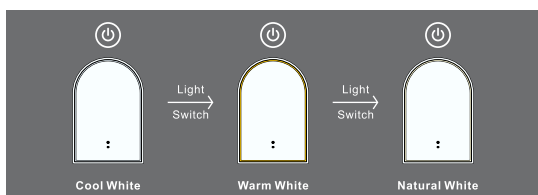
Touchless control:

LED Cabinet - Quick Start Guide

This Quick Start Guide provides clear instructions for setting up and using your LED Cabinet. The cabinet features both Sensor and Manual Modes, a defogger, adjustable LED light settings, and motion detection for hands-free operation.

Operating Modes

1. Sensor Mode (Default)

Upon initial use, the cabinet will operate in Sensor Mode. In this mode, the LED light automatically turns on when motion is detected within 1.6 meters. Under sensor mode, after the light is turned off by manual touch, it will be automatically restored to sensor mode in 30 seconds, and when people enter the sensing range again, the light will turn on automatically.

Activating Sensor Mode

If Sensor Mode is deactivated, press and hold the touch button until the sensor light blinks light blue. This indicates Sensor Mode is now active.

2. Manual Mode

To switch the cabinet from Sensor Mode to Manual Mode, follow these steps:

- While the cabinet is on, press and hold the touch button for a few seconds.
- Wait for the sensor light to turn off, indicating that Sensor Mode has been deactivated and Manual Mode is now active.

Once in Manual Mode, you can turn the LED light on or off by tapping the touch button:

- The button will illuminate blue when the light is on.
- It will turn white when the light is off or in standby mode.

Additional Features

Defogger

The defogger operates in sync with the LED light, turning on and off simultaneously.

Adjusting Colour

- Tap the touch button quickly to cycle through three colour options: Cool, Natural, and Warm.
- To turn off the light, tap the touch button after 5 seconds.
- The cabinet remembers the last selected color setting in both Sensor and Manual Modes.

Motion Detection

- Detects motion up to 1.6 meters within a 120° range.
- The LED light will automatically turn off after 10 minutes of no detected motion.
- The cabinet remembers the last selected color setting in both Sensor and Manual Modes.

Light Indicators

Sensor Status:

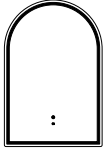
- Motion Sensor On: Ice blue indicator light.
- Motion Sensor Off: No indicator light.
- Manual Light On: Ice blue touch button.
- Manual Light Off: White touch button.

Touch Button Status:

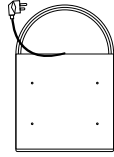
- Blue when the LED light is on.
- White when the light is off.

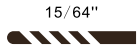

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Pre-Installation

PLANNING INSTALLATION

Compare all parts with the part listed in the package contents section if any part appears missing or damaged. Do not install and use this light. Contact customer service.

WARNING: RISK OF ELECTRICALSHOCK

- Turn off electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box before wiring fixture to the power supply.
- Turn off the power when you perform any maintenance.
- Please verify that the supply voltage is correct by comparing it with the luminaire label information.
- Make all electrical and grounded connections under the National Electrical Code, and any applicable local code requirement.

WARNING: RISK OF BURN

- Allow fixture to cool before handling. Do not touch enclosure or light source.
- Follow all lamp manufacturer's warnings, recommendations and restrictions for driver type, burning position, mounting locations/methods, replacement, and recycling.

CAUTION: RISK OF INJURY

- Wear gloves and safety glasses when removing luminaire from the carton, installing, servicing or performing maintenance.
- Avoid direct eye exposure to the light source while it is on.
- Account for small parts and destroy packing material, as these may be hazardous to children.
- Mirrors are heavy. Get assistance lifting the unit. This installation is most straightforward when performed by two people.

CAUTION: RISK OF FIRE

- Keep combustible and other materials that can burn away from luminaire and lamp/lens.

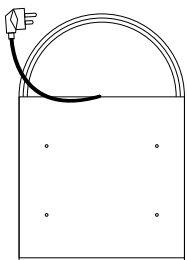

ALL WIRING SHOULD BE DONE BY A QUALIFIED LICENCED ELECTRICIAN

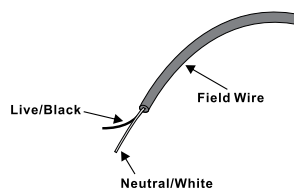
- ▲ **WARNING:** Shut off power before wiring the cabinet.
- ▲ **WARNING:** When used in bathrooms and in all other locations as required by the National Electrical Code, the electrical selector must be connected to a 220-240V (grounded dirt interrupter) protection circuit.
- ▲ **CAUTION:** Requires 220-240VAC 50/60Hz

The electric wire comes through access hole in the back of the cabinet.

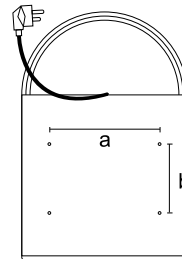

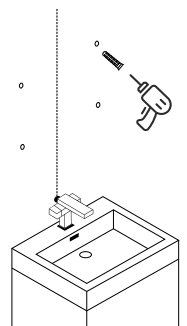

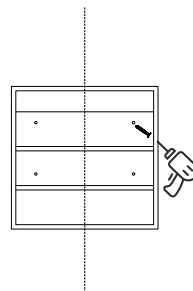
Measure the position of the installation holes.

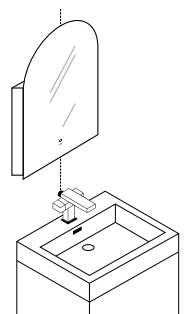
Mark the Position
